Leo was asked to provide an artist's reaction to the amazing collection of Watt's antique engineering tools, machines, and ephemera stored away in the vaults of the Science Museum in Kensington, London. The exhibition is a recreation of James Watt's 1800's workshop – all 8430 objects – which includes his prototype for the steam condenser (which initiated the Industrial Revolution) and a 3D sculpture copying machine... The film itself is a mix of photographic, live, and synthesized footage with 2D and 3D animation all mixed in together. With an atmospheric soundtrack, and unique access to the objects themselves, this is truly a one-off!
